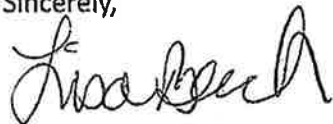

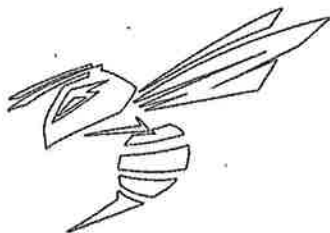

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR SECURITY SERVICES
FOR 2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR**

THIS MOU is made between the County of Pearl River, hereinafter referred to as "the County," and the Poplarville Special Municipal Separate School District, hereinafter referred to as "the School."

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS the governing authority of the County is the Board of Supervisors, and pursuant to Sections 17-25-11 and 21-19-49, Mississippi Code of 1972, the County has the authority to contract with the School to provide certified police protection to the said School on such terms and for such reimbursement as the School and the County may agree; and

WHEREAS the governing authority of the School is the Board of Trustees, and pursuant to Sections 17-25-11 and 21-19-49, Mississippi Code of 1972, the School has the authority to contract with the County to provide certified police protection to the School on such terms and for such reimbursement as the School and the County may agree; and

WHEREAS the County and the School find that the program will enhance the exercise of the police power of the County and the duty of the County to protect the public from any related criminal activity; and

WHEREAS the County and the School desire to participate in said program; and

WHEREAS the County and the School hereto state that such participation shall be accomplished through an MOU pursuant to Sections 17-25-11 and 21-19-49, Mississippi Code of 1972.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the MOU, herein set forth, the County Sheriff's Department and the School hereby agree as follows:

1. The purpose of this MOU is to provide certified police protection for the regular public school events for the 2021-2022 School Year.
2. The County may provide certified police protection when officers are available at the following regular public events held by the School:
 - a. Football - 15 Games
 - Seven (7) Varsity Home Games with six (6) police officers providing protection;
 - Four (4) 9th grade/JV Games with one (1) police officer providing protection;
 - Four (4) MSP Games with one (1) police officer providing protection;
 - b. Volleyball - 8 Games with one (1) police officer providing protection;
 - c. Soccer - 12 Games with one (1) police officer providing protection;
 - d. Basketball - 15 Games
 - Ten (10) Varsity Home Games with two (2) police officers providing protection;
 - Five (5) MSP Games with one (1) police officer providing protection;
 - e. Baseball - 15 Games
 - Ten (10) Varsity Home Games with one (1) police officer providing protection;
 - Five (5) MSP Games with one (1) police officer providing protection;
 - f. Softball - 10 Games with one (1) police officer providing protection;
 - g. Tennis - 3 Games with one (1) police officer providing protection;
 - h. Dances - Four (4) with one (1) police officer providing protection;
 - i. Prom - One (1) with two (2) police officers providing protection;
 - j. Band/Choir concerts - Four (4) with one (1) police officer providing protection;
 - k. High School Graduation - One (1) with four (4) police officers providing protection; and
 - l. Award Night Ceremony - One (1) with two (2) police officers providing protection.

Total 89 Events (78 Games and 11 Events)

3. The previous list may not be all inclusive of the school public events and may change at the discretion of the County and the School.

4. In exchange for the County's provision of police protection at the School's events, the School shall contribute an hourly rate of pay in the amount of \$30 and fringe benefits to include employer matching Social Security, Medicare, retirement, and workers' compensation for each police officer's actual hours for the 2021-2022 School Year, which funds shall be payable to Pearl River County, Poplarville, Mississippi. The final sum reimbursed shall be based on the actual number of officers and hours worked.

5. The County police officers available to the School for police protection for each category of the School's events shall be as stated in the 2021-2022 Special Events Police Protection Personnel Chart, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by reference.

6. The County shall bill and invoice the School at a minimum on a quarterly basis. The County shall bill the School on approximately September 30, 2021, December 31, 2021, March 31, 2022, on June 30, 2022. All bills and invoices must include adequate subsidiary payroll documentation to substantiate the actual costs of security services provided by the County to the School.

7. The County shall pay each of its police officers working a School event the hourly rate agreed to by the officer and the City. If any of the county's police officers works overtime, as defined by the Fair Labor Standards Act, during a School event, the county shall pay the officer at least his normal overtime rate of one and a half times his everyday regular rate of pay. Regardless of the rate the County pays the officers, the School shall only be required to reimburse the County the amount of \$30.00 per hour and benefits for each officer who works the School events.

8. If the School requests the County to supply additional certified police protection for the events specified in Paragraph Two (2) above, or for additional events other than those specified in Paragraph two (2) above, including but not limited to playoff games, away game escorts and matches of the School's various sports teams, and if the County consents thereto, the County shall be reimbursed \$30.00 per hour for the actual hours worked, including costs of benefits, for each such officer. Should overtime pay be involved as a result of such request, then it is understood and agreed that the requirements of the Fair Labor Standards Act will be followed when determining the hourly rate due such officer(s) and reimbursed by the School.

Reimbursement of such costs shall be remitted to the County within forty-five (45) days of the billing thereof.

9. In addition to the \$30.00 per hour paid by the School for the security services of the County's officers, the School shall reimburse the County for the officers' fringe benefits of Social Security, Medicare, workers' compensation, and retirement that accrue during their provision of security services to the school. The County does not have to bear any of those additional costs.

10. The School shall include the Pearl River County Sheriff's Department as certificate holder on the School's liability and automobile insurance policy pursuant to Section 11-46-15, Mississippi Code of 1972.

11. The School and the County each have approved the entering into of this MOU by appropriate resolution or order entered on their minutes.

12. Nothing in this MOU shall be to abridge any of the rights, privileges, and immunities enjoyed by the governmental entities and public officials which are parties hereto.

13. If any part, term, or provision of this MOU shall be held illegal, unenforceable, or in conflict with any law of a federal, state or local government having jurisdiction over this agreement, the validity of the remaining portions or provisions shall not be affected thereby.

14. This MOU may be terminated at will by the Board of Supervisors of the County and the Board of Trustees of the School, or by either party, upon giving written notice thirty (30) days prior to such termination provided for herein. At the end of the term of this MOU, actual costs will be calculated and reimbursed by the School within forty-five (45) days of being invoiced by the County.

15. This MOU may be amended from time to time by mutual consent of both parties through a written addendum.

16. Any future reference to this MOU may be designated "The County of Pearl River and Poplarville Special Municipal Separate School District MOU for Security Services for 2021-2022 School Year."

17. Acts and omissions of an officer in discharge of services under this MOU shall be deemed to be the acts and omissions of the School, and not the acts and omissions of the City whose uniform, weapon and vehicle are approved for the private security use. Further the School shall hold harmless and indemnify the City for any expense or loss, including attorney's fees and any damage to the official vehicle, which results from any action taken against the City arising out of the acts or omissions of the officer in discharge of private security services while wearing the official uniform or using the official weapon or vehicle.

PEARL RIVER COUNTY RECREATIONAL VEHICLE CONTROL ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pearl River County has been made aware that recreational vehicles are being used improperly or located in improper places or do not meet minimum standards for the health and safety of citizens in Pearl River County, Mississippi, and;

WHEREAS, the improper uses and/or locations of recreational vehicles in Pearl River County, Mississippi, are causing and will continue to cause immediate public health and safety hazards, and;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Mississippi law the Board of Supervisors of Pearl River County has the authority to enact such ordinances as necessary for the purpose of promoting health, safety, morals or the general welfare of the community and is empowered to regulate the location and use of buildings, structures and land for industry, residence or other purposes and to adopt any orders, resolutions or ordinances with respect to county affairs, property and finances and has determined that it is in the best interest of the public to promote public health and safety and to control the use of recreational vehicles in Pearl River County, Mississippi.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Pearl River County, Mississippi, that for the reasons set forth above and pursuant to the authority granted therein, the following ordinance is hereby enacted:

1. **SHORT TITLE.**

This Ordinance shall be known as the **Pearl River County Recreational Vehicle Control Ordinance**.

2. **INTENT.**

It is the expressed intent of the Board of Supervisors and of this Ordinance to promote a clean, healthy, safe and attractive environment in which to live.

3. **APPLICABILITY.**

This Ordinance shall apply to and be enforced within the unincorporated boundaries of Pearl River County, Mississippi.

4. **DEFINITIONS.**

The following words, phrases or terms, as used in this Ordinance unless context indicates otherwise, shall have the following meanings:

Dwelling: A house, manufactured home, shelter, structure, or building, or portion thereof, which is not readily mobile and is occupied in whole or in part as the home, residence, living quarters or sleeping place of one or more people.

Recreational Vehicle: A vehicular-type unit designed not for use as a permanent dwelling but as temporary living quarters for recreational, camping, or travel use, which either has its own motive power or is mounted on or towed by another vehicle. The basic entities include, but are not limited to a travel trailer, camping trailer, truck camper, van, and motor home.

Recreational Vehicle Park: A single parcel of land upon which recreational vehicle sites are established and maintained for occupancy by recreational vehicles of the general public as temporary living quarters for recreational camping, travel, or seasonal use, not to be confused with a mobile home or manufactured home park.

5. RECREATIONAL VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS

A. All recreational vehicles placed on property within the unincorporated boundaries of Pearl River County, Mississippi, must either:

- (1) Be on the site for fewer than 180 consecutive days within a 12 month period;
- (2) Be fully licensed and ready for highway use (a recreational vehicle is ready for highway use if it is licensed, on its road-ready wheels or jacking system, attached to the site only by quick disconnect type utilities and security devices, and has no permanently attached structures or additions);
- (3) Meet all the requirements for new construction under the County's "Family of International Building Codes Ordinance" (IBC Ordinance), which sets the minimum standards for building, plumbing, electrical, gas, sanitary, and other related codes in Pearl River County, Mississippi, including anchoring and elevation requirements; or
- (4) Be granted a hardship variance by the Director of the Pearl River Planning and Development Department.

B. All recreational vehicles placed on property within the unincorporated boundaries of Pearl River County, Mississippi, must comply with applicable state and local wastewater regulations.

C. A property owner planning to place more than two recreational vehicles on his/her/its property must comply with the minimum design/construction standards regarding sanitary facilities and with the requirements for persons

engaged in the operation of Recreational Vehicle Campgrounds as established by the Mississippi Department of Health.

6. RENTAL OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLES PROHIBITED; EXCEPTION.

Rental or leasing of recreational vehicles for use as a dwelling is prohibited, unless the recreational vehicle is located in an RV park licensed by the Mississippi Department of Health and in compliance with applicable state regulations.

7. VARIANCE PROCEDURES.

A. Designation of Variance and Appeals Board.

The Director of Pearl River Planning and Development Department is empowered and authorized to administer this ordinance and decide requests for variances from the requirements of this ordinance. The Board of Supervisors of Pearl River County shall hear and decide appeals of requests for variances from requirements of this ordinance.

B. Variance Procedures.

(1) A variance from the provisions of this ordinance may be granted by the Director of Pearl River Planning and Development Department in cases when enforcement of its provisions would result in unnecessary hardship.

(2) The board shall hear and decide appeals when it is alleged that the Director of Pearl River Planning and Development Department made an error in any requirement, decision or determination in the enforcement or administration of this ordinance.

8. ENFORCEMENT.

A. Enforcement Procedures.

(1) The Pearl River County Code Official is hereby empowered to gather all information required and to issue corrective written notices to persons in violation. The Pearl River County Code Official, or any uniformed officer of the county is hereby empowered to issue citations to persons in violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance.

(2) Prosecution for a violation of this Ordinance shall be initiated by the Pearl River County Code Official or any uniformed officer of the

county who has sufficient probable cause to believe this Ordinance is being violated. Charges under this Ordinance shall be brought in the Justice Court of Pearl River County, Mississippi.

B. Penalties.

Violation of the provisions of this ordinance or failure to comply with any of its requirements shall constitute a misdemeanor. Any person who violates this ordinance or fails to comply with any of its requirements shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not more than \$1000.00 or imprisoned for not more than 30 days, or both, and in addition, shall pay all costs and expenses involved in the case. Each day such violation continues shall be considered a separate offense. Nothing herein contained shall prevent the Pearl River County Code Official from taking such other lawful actions as are necessary to prevent or remedy any violation.

9. ORDINANCE CUMULATIVE.

This Ordinance shall be cumulative and in addition to any other laws and ordinances in force.

10. EFFECTIVE DATE.

The Board of Supervisors of Pearl River County do hereby find that it is necessary for the immediate and temporary control of the improper use and locations of recreational vehicles for this Ordinance to be made effective immediately. Accordingly, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its publication.
